M.Panco reported that he is still waiting for Mays Landing’s mutual aid agreement.

M.Corsiglia reported that driver training still needs to be done. Training officer J.Kline is in the process of lining up more training this summer.

D.Ricci reported that Ambient Comfort will change the desiccant filter the next time that they come out.

D.Ricci reported that the 75” TV for the meeting room has been picked out but not bought yet.

M.Corsiglia reported that the air test on the SCBA compressor has passed, but we still need to look into servicing it.

M.Corsiglia reported that he is still waiting for estimates on the F-1222’s new vinyl lettering.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

M.Corsiglia has a estimate from Service Tire Truck Centers for 18 new tires for F-1222 for \$12,459.22 under state contract. Motion by R.Ruggeri to purchase them 2<sup>nd</sup> by D.Ricci

M.Panco reported cracks in all of our asphalt some crack are all the way through. The cracks need to be repaired and the entire parking lot needs to be recoated. It was done approx 7 years ago. He has (1) EST for repairs from Finish Line for \$1,800.00 to fill the cracks and coat the parking lot for \$10,000. We will try to get another estimate.

M.Panco reported that the flagpole needs to be repaired the mechanism keeps jamming. He will call Capri Construction to see who works on these.

M,Corsiglia reported that the building water is still causing spotting on the trucks. We will call our soap supplier to see if he has any suggestions.
